Thank you for your interest in becoming a TeenWorks Volunteer! You are taking the first step in making a substantial difference in a teenager's life! The impact that you can have on a teenager can give them the HOPE they need to become a productive adult. In order to ensure that our youth are matched with the appropriate mentor or that you are matched with the right volunteer position, we ask that you complete this packet in full.

Here is our protocol for potential Volunteers:

Once your packet is complete, we will contact you to schedule a home visit. Should the home visit be successful, we will send you the form you need to perform a thorough background check. Once have been cleared, we will contact you in order for you to provide a copy of your driving record from the DMV, as well as a copy of your current auto insurance. Your DMV record can be obtained online and we will send you the link for easy access. Upon completion of all the above, we will contact you to schedule you for your orientation.

In order to ensure the safety of our youth, it is our responsibility to perform a thorough background screening on every potential mentor. Please feel free to contact us should you have any questions. Again thank you in advance for your interest and we will do our best to ensure the success of your mentoring experience.

What do you do next? We will review your application and work with you to be matched with a student or volunteer position. We will also provide you with training and resources that will enhance your experience! We ask that you try to maintain contact with your mentee on a weekly basis or volunteer weekly. We will be checking with you on a monthly basis; however, we welcome phone calls with any questions or concerns. You need to be aware that the teens that you will be working with are "at-risk youth," which means that often times they are not readily receptive of close relationships. It may take some time to build trust with them. This is completely normal, please be patient and feel free to reach out if you are feeling stuck and/or rejected.
